Saturday Club

Childrens Days take place almost every Saturday from 10am to 4pm

- Takes place at STEPS (The Old School) in Shepshed.
- Caters for up to 12 children per session.
- Children and young people are actively involved in the planning of the activities.
- Trips out include places like Conkers, Twin Lakes, cinema, swimming, Bradgate Park and many more.
- Parents / Carers are requested to provide a packed lunch for the day and a small amount of spending money.

Referrals are made through the Disabled Childrens Services Team. If you do not have a social worker please contact First Response on 0116 305 0005. Places can also be purchased with a direct payment or paying privately.

Holiday Play Scheme

- Takes place during every school holiday.
- Provides the opportunity for up to 12 children with learning disabilities to have fun, take part in a range of activities and be themselves in a safe and stimulating environment.

All staff are highly trained, experienced and hold a current DBS.

The staff and volunteers make every effort to ensure that the experiences are memorable, from trips out in the community to multi-sensory sessions, from outdoor challenges such as cycling, canoeing and archery to playing with animals first hand.

Places are referred via social services. Please contact First Response if you do not have a social worker on 0116 305 0005. Places can be accessed with a direct payment or by purchasing privately.

After School Club

- Takes place at STEPS (The Old School) in Shepshed.
- Provides a safe haven for up to 15 children when they have finished their school day.
- Meets on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 3.30pm to 5.30pm.

Children arrive on school transport, have a light tea and enjoy activities of their choice such as outdoor play, cookery, arts and crafts, computers, multi-sensory sessions.

Domiciliary Care

We offer Domiciliary Care for children from 8 to 17 years of age. Whether you want support just once or on a regular basis we have qualified staff that can help support you in your home. We can help with a range of services, including a sitting service and personal care. Depending on your budget, we can shape and deliver the support you need, when and where you need it.
